Radm Paige has over 34 years experience in key leadership, management and decision making positions within the Department of Defense, predominately in the areas of systems development, test, and sustainment of complex integrated weapons systems, weapon system networks and global ballistic missile defense systems. Her experience spans joint and coalition initiatives as well as Navy surface, air, submarine and C4I systems. Long noted for consistently delivering effective weapon systems to the operational forces, Radm Paige was repeatedly tasked by both the U.S. Navy and the Missile Defense

Agency (MDA) to create and assume positions to address the acquisition and engineering of emerging warfighting needs. These last two positions resulted in four straight successful flight tests, between Aegis BMD and Ground-based Midcourse Defense Program.
